Chili Cook-Off 2024 Rules

The following rules and regulations will apply to all entries in the Swains Creek Chili Cook-Off held Saturday, October 5, 2024, at the Swains Creek Pavilion.

- 1. All types of chili are welcome.
- 2. Chili Cook Off entries should be pre-cooked, completely prepared and ready to serve. Entries can be brought anytime after 3:30pm and must be ready to be judged at 4:00pm.
- 3. Judging of chili cook off entries will be conducted during the first hour by the CMFPD Fire Department. Each attendee will also get one voting ticket to decide the People's Choice winners.
- 4. Power source will be provided for the use of your slow cooker or other warming devices during the contest.
- 5. Contestants may also include sides and condiments to enhance the taste of their chili such as cheese, sour cream, onions, cilantro, hot peppers, crackers, bread, etc.
- 6. Each contestant must cook and provide enough chili for judging and tasting purposes.
- 7. Judging will be determined based on the following criteria:
 - a. Appearance
 - b. Aroma
 - c. Consistency
 - d. Taste
 - e. After-taste
- 8. There will be prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places for best overall chili, and an award to the People's Choice winners.
- 9. Bowls and spoons for sampling will be provided by the Swains Creek Chili Cook-Off committee.
